i. to differentiate between Faith and the shield of faith *ii.* to expose the effects of the shield of Faith on satanic arrows.

INTRODUCTION

In study 34 of this outline, we studied Faith as a manifestation of the fruit of the spirit. Then, we analysed various manifestations of faith by Biblical heroes and how manifestation of our Christian faith can set the basis for soul-winning into Christ's kingdom. In this study, we shall concentrate on how we can defend or proof the efficacy of our Christian Faith amidst various arrows of the enemies. A shield is used mainly as a form of protection and offensive to knock down enemies in the battle front. Shield of faith is meant to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil ones ranging from false teachings, false miracles and arrows of persecution.

CONCLUSION: The shield of faith covers our most vulnerable spots, especially our hearts as it can be filled with fear, hopelessness, discouragement, self-pity and all satanic arrows of wickedness. Therefore, we should always put it on in our journey to the kingdom of God.

ETERNAL SALVATION MADE POSSIBLE

(i) Prepare Yourself

"But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, putting on faith and love as a breastplate and the hope of salvation as a helmet. For God did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ." - 1 Thessalonia 5:8&9.

Prior to the coming of Jesus Christ, the prospect of Eternal Salvation appeared unachievable for humanity. The obstacle of sin, the world, and the devil seemed insurmountable, leading to a dead-end for mankind. Nevertheless, in the fullness of time, God intervened and reached out to reconcile with humanity by sending His only Son, Jesus Christ, to pay the ransom that liberated humanity from the abyss of unimaginable agony to which they had been condemned since the fall. (see Galatians 4:4&5) In other words, through the sacrifice of Christ, every believer has escaped the second death and gained an unending life experience of eternal salvation. The soul is saved from the endless punishment and condemnation that awaits it after death. Accordingly, Christianity hinges on this assurance of Eternal Salvation, the ultimate rescue of the soul from eternal damnation and the gateway to eternal life.

Our theme, "Eternal Salvation made possible," is an attestation of the immense power of God with whom all things are possible, as stated in Matthew 19:26. and what He has done to rescue us from eternal damnation. Out of His love for us, He sent His Son, Jesus Christ, to bear our punishment and endure suffering in our stead. By His divine power and purpose, we are eternally saved from our sins and can now spend eternity with Him in heaven. We declare it in *Te Deum*: "When he hadst overcome the sharpness of death, he didst open the kingdom of heaven to all believers." Albeit, believers are urged to prepare themselves for the full enjoyment of this divine gift. The essence of this preparation lies in improving readiness, efficiency, performance, or outcomes in spiritual matters.

1 Thessalonians 5:8-9 emphasises vigilance and moral integrity as the core of the believer's preparation, portraying faith, love, and hope as spiritual armour against sin and spiritual complacency. Eternal salvation is not earned but a gift from God to humanity. It is realised by faith and serviced by love and hope. "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast." (Ephesians 2:8).

Faith is an indispensable component of a believer's journey towards eternal life. It acts as a shield, guarding us against the trials, doubts, and temptations that beset us (Ephesians 6:16). Faith is not just about acknowledging God's existence but a deep-seated conviction that governs our actions and decisions. It protects us against the "arrows" of doubt, despair, false teachings, and moral failings that could lead us to sin and complacency.

Living in Love too is an essential part of preparation. Love acts as a breastplate, protecting the heart, which is a person's core. However, it is vital to understand that there are two types of love - love for God and love for others, as mentioned in Matthew 22:37-39. Love is crucial in motivating us to live righteously, serve others selflessly, and avoid actions that may harm others or ourselves. It acts as a guard against selfishness, bitterness, hatred, and indifference, leading to spiritual stagnation and sin.

As we prepare ourselves, Hope is another essential spiritual gear to carry. It refers to the firm belief in what God has promised, precisely salvation through Jesus Christ. It serves as a helmet, protecting the mind and influencing thoughts and perspectives. It helps believers persevere through hardships, resist discouragement, and stay committed to their faith journey. It also safeguards against despair, cynicism, and the temptation to give up when faced with life's challenges.

Watchfulness is another essential step in the believer's preparation. Watchfulness characterises the attitudes of the disciples who await with hope the return of Jesus. It demands alertness to dangers and detachment from earthly pleasures and activities (see Luke 21:34-36). The parable of the ten virgins emphasises the imminence of the *parousia* (Matt 25:1-13). Jesus urged His disciples in Matthew 24:42-44: "Therefore be on the alert, for you do not know which day your Lord is coming. But be sure of this that if the head of the house had known at what time of the night the thief was coming, he would have been on the alert and would not have allowed his house to

be broken into. For this reason, you also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour when you do not think He will."

Underpinning the aforementioned is Repentance, which involves recognising one's sins, seeking God's forgiveness, and making necessary amends. It means turning away from sin and turning towards God. Repentance is directly linked to salvation and eternal life. It is through repentance and faith in Jesus Christ that one can be forgiven and reconciled with God, opening the path to eternal salvation (cf Acts 20:21). The Scripture says: "The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance." (2 Peter 3:9). For the believer, this requires regular self-examination, i.e., regularly assessing one's life in light of Scripture to maintain a lifestyle of integrity and holiness.

As we approach another Advent Season, let us be fully prepared for the coming of the Lord.
