- ii. to discuss the spiritual importance of having the Helmet of Salvation as Christians.*

INTRODUCTION

Helmet is a hard or padded hat that is purposely meant to protect the head against fracture or total breakage during an accident. The human head is the most important of all parts of the body and it houses major sensory organs, and without the head, the whole body is useless. Salvation is deliverance from our sins and the harmful consequences which is eternal death. Therefore, as the head is the most important part of the body, so is salvation the most important part of our Christian. Without salvation of our souls, all other Christian livelihood is useless and in vain. Therefore, the spiritual helmet of salvation is the insulation of our minds against sinful suggestions, desires, and traps the devil may lay for us as it is analysed in our text for today (Lk 21:34-36).

1. Explain the Helmet of Salvation in the context of the introduction and in line with Gen 39:9; 2Tim 2:22.
2. From the following passages, analyse the likely causes or arrows of crash to the grace of salvation. Judg 16:1-4; Jn 12:4-6; Acts 5:1-3; 2Tim 2:16.
3. In a decadent generation, what warnings concerning possible crash of our grace of salvation? Lk 21:34-36; 1Th 5:6; 1Pe 4:7; 5:8-9.
4. How do we put on (wear) the spiritual helmet of salvation? Psa 1:2; 63:5-6; 119:11; Heb 10:24-25.

CONCLUSION: Our ability to meditate regularly on the word of God, to pray, to embrace godly fellowship and profess the genuine Faith in Christ in all circumstances; are spiritual helmet to protect the grace of salvation in our Christian lives.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT: There can be spiritual accident! Wear your salvation helmet.

ARTICLE IX

9. Original or Birth-sin

Original sin is not found merely in the following of Adam's example (as the Pelagians foolishly say). It is rather to be seen in the fault and corruption which is found in the nature of every person who is naturally descended from Adam. The consequence of this is that man is far gone from his original state of righteousness. In his own nature he is predisposed to evil, the sinful nature in man always desiring to behave in a manner contrary to the Spirit. In every person born into this world there is found this predisposition which rightly deserves God's anger and condemnation. This infection within man's nature persists even within those who are regenerate. This desire of the sinful nature, which in Greek is called *phronema sarkos* and is variously translated the wisdom or sensuality or affection or desire of the sinful nature, is not under control of God's law. Although there is no condemnation for those that believe and are baptized, nevertheless the apostle states that any such desire is sinful.

ETERNAL SALVATION MADE POSSIBLE

(ii) Recognising and Scaling the Hurdles

“Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us.”
Hebrews 12:1

Hurdles are the barriers that block our progress in life, and overcoming them is key to achieving our goals. In the Bible, we find hurdles that impede the attainment of eternal salvation. As believers, it is essential to develop spiritual sensitivity to recognise these hurdles and ways to overcome them. Hebrews 12:1 calls us to live a life of faith, inspired by the examples of past believers, and free from the encumbrances of sin and other distractions. The following are some of the hurdles that can inhibit eternal salvation and the modalities to overcome them:

The Hurdle of Materialism: Luke 18:18-30 portrays a significant hurdle, as illustrated through the story of a wealthy young ruler seeking guidance from Jesus on inheriting eternal life. The young ruler claims to have followed all the commandments from his youth, but his attachment to his possessions becomes a significant obstacle when Jesus asks him to sell everything and give to the poor, leading the young ruler to feel disheartened. However, to overcome this hurdle, one must prioritise spiritual values, practice generosity and contentment, trust in God’s provision, and live simply while focusing on gratitude, as highlighted in Matthew 6:19-21.

The Hurdle of Doubt: Doubt is a hurdle that challenges the believer’s trust in God and His promises and thus inhibits the believer from enjoying God’s provisions of eternal life. The story of Thomas, who doubted the resurrection of Jesus until he saw Him in person (John 20:24-29), is a classic example. Overcoming doubt involves a combination of faith, prayer, engagement with Scripture, reliance on the Holy Spirit, support from faithful brethren, learning from biblical examples, and actively living out one’s faith. The Bible emphasises having faith in God’s promises and character. Hebrews 11:1 defines faith as “confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.”

The Hurdle of Sinful Habits: The struggle against sins and moral weaknesses is a significant spiritual hurdle on the path to eternal salvation. Apostle Paul’s discussion of his personal struggle with sin in Romans 7:15-25 illustrates this. To overcome this hurdle, the believer must be spiritually disciplined, seek God’s help, and be grounded in an understanding of God’s grace and the transformative power of faith. Paul says: “Therefore, I do not run like someone running aimlessly; I do not fight like a boxer beating the air. No, I strike a blow to my body and make it my slave so that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified for the prize.” (1 Corinthians 9:26&27)

The Hurdle of Persecution: Persecution refers to the hardships, discrimination, or hostility that believers face due to their faith. It is a test of one’s endurance and commitment to their faith. The Bible encourages us to persevere in the face of persecution and endure it with strength supplied by the Holy Spirit. In James 1:12, it is written, “Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.”

The Hurdle of Temptation: The hurdle of temptation is a common and significant challenge in the spiritual journey, as the Bible describes. It involves being enticed or drawn towards thoughts, words, or actions that are contrary to God’s will or moral laws. Temptation works with the human sinful nature to obstruct their journey with God to eternal life. James 1:14 asserts: “...each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed.” The Bible acknowledges that temptation is a universal and inevitable experience. Esau fell for this hurdle in Genesis 25:21ff, while Joseph the Dreamer in Genesis 39, out of his resoluteness not to sin against God, scaled the same hurdle. 1 Corinthians 10:13 states, “No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind.” Believers often face choices that test their faithfulness and obedience to God’s commandments, but we are encouraged to rely on God’s strength and promise to resist temptation. Philippians 4:13 says, “I can do all this through him who strengthens me.”

The Hurdle of Unforgiveness: Unforgiveness is when you refuse or find it difficult to pardon someone who has caused you harm. It can lead to negative emotions like bitterness, resentment, and other spiritual consequences. Unforgiveness is a significant spiritual obstacle to eternal life since it contradicts the Bible’s teachings on love and forgiveness (Matthew 18:21-35). Overcoming the hurdle of Unforgiveness is not only an obligation but also a path to personal peace, spiritual growth, and healthier relationships with God and others. As believers, we are

called to forgive because we have been forgiven by God (Ephesians 4:32). By forgiving others, we demonstrate our understanding and appreciation of the forgiveness that we have received from God through Christ.

Let us rid ourselves of any burden or sin that impedes our spiritual progress, just as a runner discards any unnecessary weight to run effectively. With faith and endurance, we can overcome any hurdle that comes our way and achieve our goals. Hebrews 12:12-13 encourages us to renew our spiritual vigour and commitment to righteous living to run this race. Our eternal salvation has been made possible; let us, therefore, run our race, "fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith."
