39 ARTICLES OF RELIGION ARTICLE XVII

17. Predestination and Election

Predestination to life is the eternal purpose of God, whereby (before the foundations of the world were laid) he has consistently decreed by his counsel which is hidden from us to deliver from curse and damnation those whom he has chosen in Christ out of mankind and to bring them through Christ to eternal salvation as vessels made for honor. Hence those granted such an excellent benefit by God are called according to God's purpose by his Spirit working at the appropriate time. By grace they obey the calling; they are freely justified, are made sons of God by adoption, are made like the image of his only-begotten Son Jesus Christ, they walk faithfully in good works and at the last by God's mercy attain eternal happiness. The reverent consideration of this subject of predestination and of our election in Christ is full of sweet, pleasant, and inexpressible comfort to the godly and to those who feel within themselves the working of the Spirit of Christ, putting to death the deeds of the sinful and earthly nature and lifting their minds up to high and heavenly things. This consideration establishes and confirms their belief in the eternal salvation o be enjoyed through Christ and kindles a fervent love towards God. But for inquisitive and unspiritual persons who lack the Spirit of Christ to have thesentence of God's predestination continually before their eyes is a dangerous snare which the deviluses to drive them either into desperation or into recklessly immoral living (a state no less perilous than desperation). Furthermore we need to receive God's promises in the manner in which they are generally set out to us in Holy Scripture, and in our actions we need to follow that will of God which is clearly declared to us in the Word of God.

POSITIONING OURSELVES FOR RESTORATION (ii) Responding to God's Loving Gestures:

Befriend Him Again

"Come now, let us settle the matter," says the Lord. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool." - Isaiah 1:18

In Luke 15, the Bible presents three parables relevant to our meditation's theme. In these parables, Jesus paints a beautiful picture of God's loving gestures and His desire to see the lost return to Him. The first parable is about a lost sheep and a shepherd who goes to great lengths to find it, emphasising the celebration upon its discovery (vv. 3-7). The second parable tells the story of a woman who diligently searches for her lost coin and rejoices when she finds it (vv. 8-10). The last, most famous, and most extended parable in this chapter is the parable of the lost son, whose father welcomes him back with open arms even after squandering his inheritance (vv. 11-32).

These parables illustrate God's persistent pursuit of sinners and encourage them to repent and accept His love again. Hence, the charge in our theme is to respond to God's loving gestures and befriend Him again. Ezekiel stresses this divine love thus: "Have I any pleasure in the death of the wicked, declares the Lord God, and not rather that he should turn from his way and live?" (Ezekiel 18:23). Similarly, Romans 10:21 says that God stretches His hands out to those who have rebelled against Him, imploring them to return.

The parable of the prodigal son expatiates this. When the son finally realised the magnitude of his mistake, he decided to return home and work as his father's servant, knowing he had no right to expect anything else. His repentance was genuine and heartfelt, as he acknowledged sinning against God and his father. When he finally returned home, he expected to be reprimanded, but instead, his father ran to him and embraced him with open arms. Despite the father's social status, he did not hesitate to show mercy and love to his son.

Like the prodigal son, we who have strayed from God, the Father Almighty, should rethink and respond appropriately to His loving gestures of God. His promise in John 6:38 - "Those who come to me I will not cast out" - is a powerful statement that reflects His unconditional acceptance and love for sinners. God welcomes all who seek Him, regardless

of their past, mistakes, or circumstances. It is a comforting promise that assures us that we are never rejected when we approach Him.

To befriend God again, the following steps are of the essence:

- Wash and Make Yourselves Clean: The first step involves a heartfelt examination of one's life, acknowledging sins, and seeking forgiveness. This cleansing is not just external but requires a profound internal transformation, a turning away from wrongful actions and thoughts.
- Create time with God: Devoting time to being alone with God offers the opportunity to cultivate a stronger bond with Him. This is akin to how we form close relationships with our companions by consistently being available for them and nurturing the connection. Likewise, regularly carving out quality time to connect with God helps to deepen our comprehension of Him. Scripture records that "the Lord would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend" (Exodus 33:11).
- Show reverence to God: Our closeness with God is rooted in intimacy and reverence. The Bible says, "The friendship of the Lord is for those who fear him, and he makes known to them his covenant" (Psalm 25:14). Befriending God does not diminish our reverence for Him, for He is the Lord of lords and King of kings. As we approach Him with awe, He will share with us what lies in His heart.
- Absolute Obedience to Him: Jesus says, "You are my friends if you do what I command" (John 15:14). We build a relationship with Jesus when we obey God's commands. It is not just enough to listen to God tell us what is on His heart - including His counsel and corrections for us - we also must do what He confides in us.
- Love Him unwaveringly, intimately, and sacrificially: Loving God as a friend requires us to be fiercely loyal, deeply intimate, and selflessly sacrificial, just as He loves us. Bible says: "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength." (Deuteronomy 6:4&5)

God desires to reason with us, show us His mercy, and offer us a fresh start. In Isaiah 1:18, He says, "Come now, let us settle the matter. Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool." This can only be love at work for God Almighty to invite sinners to a tete-a-tete. We must respond to this divine loving gesture and be friendly with God again, for in doing so, we will discover His boundless love and grace.
