Bible Study Outline

THEME: THE CHRISTIAN RACE

SUB-THEME: The Broad Way- 1

TOPIC: The Deceitful way

TEXT: Gen. 3:1-8

AIM: To help participants understand what the Broadway is all about and how deceitful it is.

INTRODUCTION

We greet all our mothers today, as they celebrate the Mothering Sunday. We wish them blissful years ahead in Jesus name. Grammatically, Broadway simply means “a large open or main road.” In our text today, we read of how Eve was smoothly deceived and lured into disobeying God. The Lord Jesus used the term, ‘broad’ to refer to a kind of Christianity where everything goes freely and smoothly with little or no caution to such way of life. This study will help us understand the broad-way not just as dangerous but also deceitful.

STUDY GUIDES

1. What do you understand by “the deceitful way” in the context of our study today? Compare with Prov 26:24-26
2. From the words of Christ “...for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it” in Matt.7:13; identify the “Broadway elements” from the discussion between the serpent and the woman in Genesis 3:1-8.
3. Discuss how the devil deceives Christians today through the “Broadway” concept. 2Cor. 11:13-15. What is the way out?
4. In the context of 2Tim 4:1-3, discuss the need for genuine discipleship in our Churches today as a remedy for the devil’s “sweet” deceits.

CONCLUSION: The devil indeed is subtle, as recorded in the Scriptures. He knows that the way to achieve his purpose is to portray evil as good. Therefore, we must not be ignorant of the devices of this dangerous being that deceitfully appears as an “angel of light”.

RESTORING GODLY VALUES AT HOME:

THE ROLE OF MOTHERS

I am reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded that it now lives in you also."

2 Timothy 1:5.

Mothers are the divine embodiment of unconditional love, compassion, and empathy. They possess an innate ability to nurture their children, instil moral values, and inspire them to lead a righteous life. A mother's influence in the household is immeasurable, for she is the cornerstone of the family's emotional and spiritual well-being. Through her steady faith and devotion, a mother creates a safe and secure environment that fosters growth, learning, and development. Her tireless efforts and sacrifices are often taken for granted, but her impact on her children's lives is profound and everlasting. Elder M. Russell Ballard, commenting on the unparalleled significance of mothers' roles in their children's lives and society at large, says, "There is no role in life that is more essential than that of motherhood."

Today, we gather to recognise and pay tribute to mothers' fundamental role in our lives. We celebrate their exceptional influence in fostering and nurturing godly values within the sanctity of our homes. Through the lens of Scripture, we can discover the divine calling placed upon mothers - a calling that encompasses virtues like strength, wisdom, and faith. Our readings for this celebration, 2 Timothy 1:1-10, Proverbs 31:10-31, and Matthew 14:1-12, give a better understanding of the sacred responsibility entrusted to mothers.

In his letter to Timothy, the Apostle Paul emphasised the genuine faith that was first instilled in Timothy's grandmother Lois and his mother Eunice (2 Timothy 1:5). This passage beautifully portrays the passing down of faith through generations. It highlights the crucial role that mothers and grandmothers play in planting and nurturing the seeds of belief and righteousness in their children. The mention of Lois and Eunice before Timothy underscores the concept of a spiritual legacy within families. The faith of one generation can profoundly impact the succeeding ones, shaping their beliefs, values, and actions. In other words, mothers are entrusted with the spiritual education of their offspring, a responsibility that shapes the faith landscape of future generations. By living a life of faith and sharing the Gospel within the home, mothers lay a foundation of godly values that can withstand the trials and tribulations of this world.

Proverbs 31 offers a vivid picture of what a godly woman looks like. This passage emphasises that a virtuous mother is a priceless gem, far more valuable than even the most precious rubies. It's not just a list of duties to check off but rather a tribute to the remarkable strength, wisdom, diligence, and reverence for the Lord that define a virtuous mother. She is not only a caregiver but also a provider, a counsellor, and a spiritual mentor for her family. Her actions and teachings within the home create an environment where godly values thrive and flourish.

This passage illustrates that mothers have a divine calling to be virtuous examples, leading their families with love, wisdom, and grace and demonstrating the beauty of a life dedicated to serving God and others. It shows that motherhood is not simply a biological function but a high and holy calling that requires the utmost devotion, sacrifice, and commitment. Following the example of the virtuous mother described in Proverbs 31, mothers can inspire their families to live with purpose, dignity, and integrity and walk in the Lord's ways.

In Matthew 14:1-12, the story of Herod, Herodias, and her daughter is a powerful cautionary tale about the role of a mother and the influence she wields. It highlights the importance of using that power responsibly and with ethical considerations. The story challenges mothers to reflect on how their actions and guidance can shape their children's lives and impact the world around them. It emphasises the significant responsibility that comes with being a mother and the need to use that role to influence their children positively. It demonstrates how a mother's desires and vendettas can shape her children's actions. Herodias' direct influence on her

daughter to ask for John the Baptist's head is a stark example of how a mother's actions can have dire consequences. Thus, the story underscores the importance of mothers guiding their children with wisdom and virtue and using their influence to promote positive and ethical values. It is a reminder that the role of a mother is influential, and it should be wielded with care and responsibility.

On the occasion of Mothering Sunday, I urge all mothers to use their power to save our homes and society now. The decline in our homes and society is alarmingly severe, and we cannot afford to ignore it. As caretakers and nurturers of nature, you have been endowed by God with the ability to repair it. You are our last hope! I pray the Lord will empower you with strength, wisdom, and grace to carry out this challenging task in Jesus' name.
